The \$275 assessment fee is not covered by insurance. Barb Certa- Werner from HHCS said she could apply for a possible grant that she knows is available that would help pay the assessment fee for 9 or so people but the deadline is December 31st.

LSS also provides group counsiling such as Thinking for a change. This is for men and woman out of prison. This group will help with strengthening problem solving and social skills.

There is also a mens non violence group.

Justine is head of the Budgeting and debt management program that offers a wide variety of tools to crawl out from under your debt.

Ashley Meyers helps with the process of special needs adoptions or parents that are looking for info on putting their child up for adoption.
