Detailed Responsibilities	1. Selecting a Delegate to attend Membership meetings and notifying the Board of Directors of any change made with regard to such selection in a writing signed by the President or other chief executive officer of the local coalition. 	 Promptly pay Membership dues. BCHHC Director and Treasurer to ensure timely payment.
	3. Promptly providing reports and other information requested by the Corporation Board of Directors. Reports requested to be compiled accordingly by BCHHC Director and/or Executive Committee in collaboration with Delegate and provided to Corporation in a timely manner.
	4. Assist in the identification and recruitment of new Members and Directors. BCHHC Advocacy and Membership Committees responsible for any such identification and communication with Delegate for further recruitment.
	5. Support the mission of the Corporation within the Member's geographic area. Full membership BCHHC and Systems Committee communications and monthly meetings will promote and share information, values, and mission of Corporation.
