

After Hours Plan for Ozaukee County Continuum of Care

Advocates of Ozaukee (262-284-6902 or 877-375-4034) is the after-hours point of contact for any person/family experiencing homelessness. They are available by phone 24x7 and can assess a homeless person/family and determine their immediate needs. This takes place for those fleeing domestic violence as well as those who are not fleeing domestic violence. Area law enforcement will contact Advocates if they become aware of anyone homeless. Advocates will complete the WIBOSCOC Pre-Screen form and make a referral to Family Promise for the next business day when the person/family can access the Coordinated Entry system for the county.

If appropriate for their emergency shelter, Advocates may be able to provide shelter to the homeless person/family. Advocates serves persons fleeing domestic violence and those who are not fleeing domestic violence.

This plan is shared with all members of the CoC via email and will be reviewed annually at a CoC meeting in the last quarter of the calendar year.
