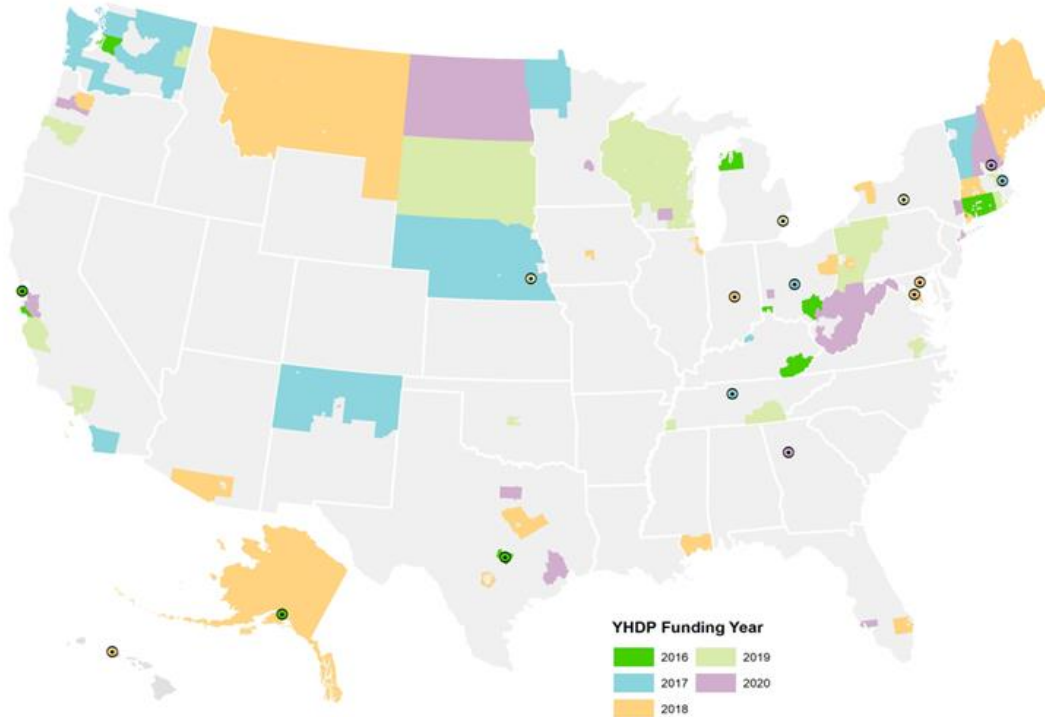


Congratulations!

What makes YHDP different from other HUD work?

- **A focus on authentic engagement from youth with lived expertise of homelessness**
 - As planners, decision makers, and leaders
- **Focus on specific values & principles**
 - Equity, family engagement, housing first, positive youth development & trauma informed care, unsheltered homelessness, youth choice, individualized & client driven supports,. Social and community integration, coordinated entry, and focus on special populations of youth
- **The Coordinated Community Plan (CCP) requirement**
 - Intentional time is set aside for local planning on how we will prevent and end homelessness
 - Plan must be approved by HUD before access to project funding is made available
- **YHDP comes with robust and intensive Technical Assistance as support and capacity building**

Authentic Youth Collaboration: Guiding Principles

- **Set leaders up for success.** *Before asking YYA for their expertise, ensure they have the necessary tools to support them throughout the process.*
- **Reduce barriers to participation.** *Provide various channels for YYA leaders to offer their input and feedback.*
- **Set clear and realistic deadlines.** *Be mindful that YYA have personal lives outside of this work.*
- **Highlight the impact of the work.** *Give clear examples of how youth input was influential in the final decision or product.*
