Prevention Work Group

Working on a new Prevention Assessment

- Will be done soon. We're hopeful it will be sent to CE Committee in January for approval
- Purpose is to ensure the assessment is equitable and the questions are more directly related to prevention and potential barriers

Emergency Shelter Work Group

• Emergency Shelter Standards were approved by the Board of Directors on Nov. 7th, 2023

New CE Homeless Assessment

On Nov. 7th, it was voted on and approved by the Board of Directors

We created a timeline of the next steps to take before it is implemented.

CE Assessment Timeline

Trainings

For agencies that participate in CE

- CE Pre-screen and Barriers Assessment Nov. 20th at 3:30 pm.
- HMIS how to enter the assessment into the system Nov. 28th at 9:00 am
- Non-HMIS how to enter the assessment into the system at 11:00 am

Transition Period – Dec 1, 2023 SSOs will run the priority lists. These will be used during a 2-week transition period to fill housing opening.

During the 2-week period, all agencies must work to transition clients currently enrolled in CE by reassessing them with the new CE Barriers Assessment

We go live! – Dec. 18, 2023



New reports will be active.



Clients that are not transitioned with a new assessment will show up with their assessment score missing.

This will flag the agencies that they need to reassess that person(s)

SSO staff and agencies that participate in CE will continue to work at getting that resolved.
