Homeless Prevention Funding in the DHC and Coordinated Entry

- WRAP (Wisconsin Rental Assistance Program) Western Dairyland has dispersed over \$500,000 and so far the program has helped between 200-300 households. Assistance available until the end of October. Funding only for those affected by COVID
- EHH Prevention (Catholic Charities) ends 09/30/21 for those NOT affected by COVID
- ESG CV: Agencies have the contracts for the funding. People must have had their income affected by COVID and be at 80% median county income. EHH Prevention (LSS) – ends in 2022 – only for those affected by COVID
- CDBG EC City Housing received large amount of funding.
