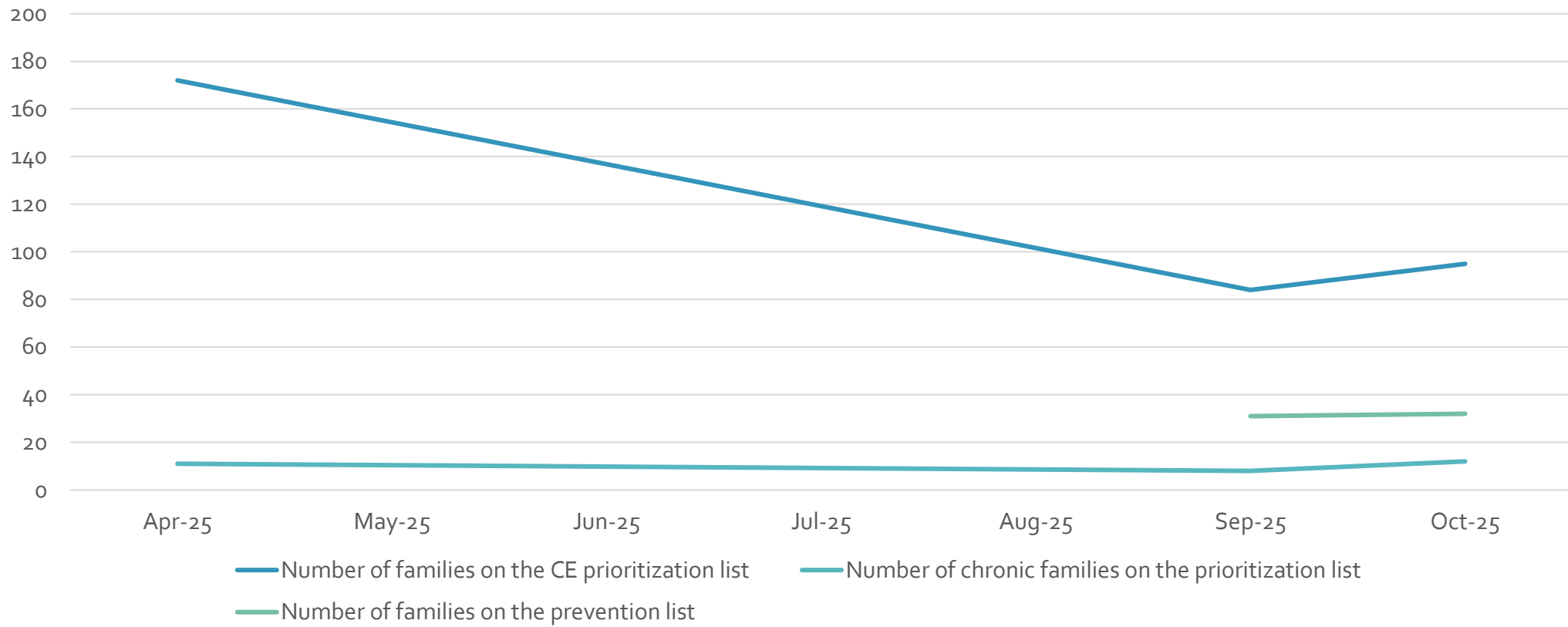

# Overview



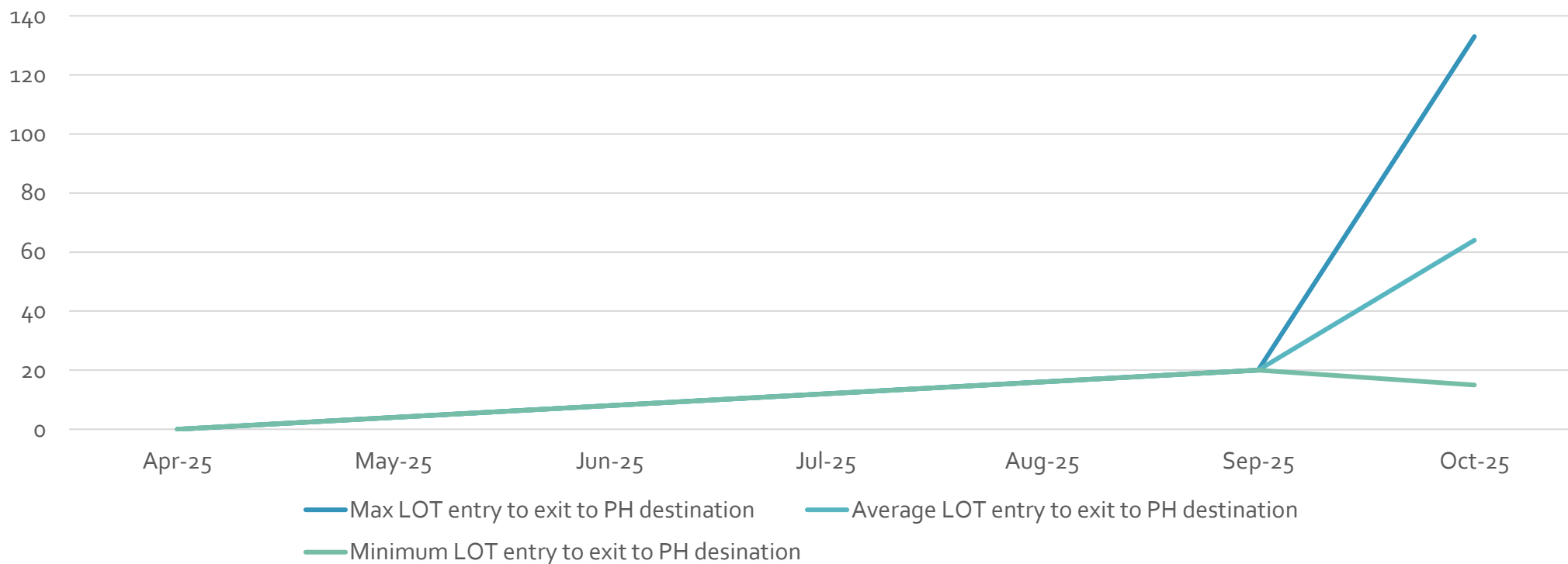
- Pilot project began spring 2024.

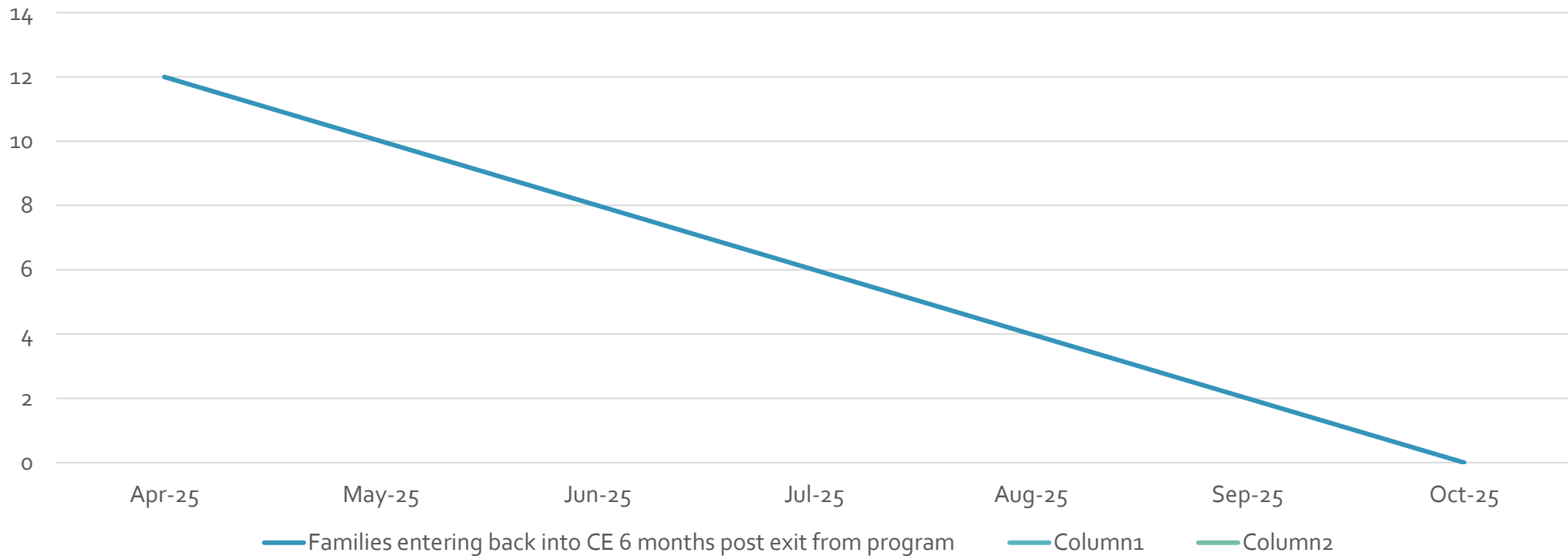
# Metric C: Reduction in Families Experiencing First Time Category 1 Homelessness
