In addition the bills we are receiving from SWCAP are being sent months later which can lead to forgotten information ie names, etc. It would be helpful if bills could be sent to us on a monthly basis. Sam will check with Social Services to ask if there is any way that we could run background checks through their agency. Hannah and Bev will follow up with Fred at DSS. Hannah will check with Iowa Cty homeless task force regarding their cost and process of background checks.
