## United Way Community Closet & Boots to Work, Guest Presenter: Tara Glodowski

Tara is the Associate Director of Affinity Groups, Women in Action and Rebecca's Closet, United Way Rebecca's Closet – request form for baby and children items are available on the United Way of Marathon County website, <a href="www.unitedwaymc.org">www.unitedwaymc.org</a>. By agency referral only, not open to the general public. There's about a 1 week turn around, but agencies can come and check out a key and find items if need them more quickly. Items are available seasonally – now closet has fall and winter clothes.

Career Closet – has clothes for job interviews, for those who receive employment they can come back and get up to 5 outfits. Open to the general public.

Boots to Work – steel-toed boots for those who just received a job offer or just started and boots are required for job. Need a voucher to access boots. Men's and women's shoes are available. Voucher can be found on the United Way of Marathon County website, www.unitedwaymc.org.

Donations needed: women's plus size, scrubs, men's shoes and belts for Career Closet. Drop them off at the United Way or at the Closet during business hours.

Example shared by Roberto Partarrieu is La Crosse is using the Housing First model to eradicate homelessness; they brought in a consultant to help Catholic Charities and local leaders identify and implement solutions. Catholic Charities is planning to bring the consultant to the Wausau location – HHC could possibly help coordinate.
