WHAT: POINT-IN-TIME STREET OUTREACH EVENT

The Point-In-Time (PIT) Street Outreach Event surveys people living on the streets in Kenosha through the efforts of social service providers and community volunteers. Volunteers will receive an orientation at Kenosha Human Development Services, Inc. located at 5407 8th Avenue prior to conducting street outreach activities.

The orientation will provide instruction on safety, confidentiality, how to approach people on the streets, documentation, and where to search in assigned areas. Volunteers are assigned to groups led by an experienced PIT Group Leader. Group Leaders guide volunteers in the community to:

- Distribute care packages
- Provide information and referral
- Conduct brief interviews
- Document observations
