

Minutes from meeting held

January 19, 2017

Rice Lake, WI

Connie from LightHouse shelter stated that she is continuing to work on opening a shelter for men.

Rusk county was given \$2,000.00 from the Packers allocated for use in providing motel rooms for people in need.

Duana stated that we need to use up the TBRA monies by the end of the contract. She will be asking for an extension.

This includes Hours, Rent calculations, TBRA forms with the first 6 boxes completed for your monthly rent calculations. Duana is missing some MOU's that need to be taken care of ASAP.

Connie and Jeff-Rusk County Duana will touch base with Melonie for Clark and Taylor.

It was suggested that we have a community breakfast in Burnett County to bring homeless out so we can get a better count. Washburn County will host a dinner. We would feed them and give folks necessities and a room if needed.

There was a lot of discussion on what is happening in Rice Lake with the Warming House and the Family House. These services are needed in this area and also available to other counties if need be.

Beginning in January there will be Webinar training for the new priority list and Leigh will keep everyone posted on that. She will run a live session to help those that use Service Point be comfortable with what they enter.

The group also discussed the Salvation Army continue their role as lead agency. It was unanimous that SA continue.

Our next meeting will be held the second Tuesday of April via conference call and Duana will send out an email with the particulars prior to that meeting.
