MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

PARTIES TO THE AGREEMENT: Bay Area Workforce Board, 317 W. Walnut Street, Green Bay, WI 54303 and Family Services of Northeast Wisconsin, 300 Crooks Street Green Bay, WI 54301. This will include all homeless persons from all local agencies involved with the Brown County Homeless and Housing Coalition and rural communities.

PURPOSE OF THE AGREEMENT: Coordinate prioritized access to employment and/or high-demand training programs with sponsored homeless or housing insecure participants.

PROJECT TIME FRAME: August 1, 2019 until directed otherwise.

FISCAL: No additional funding is being provided beyond current contracted WIOA services.


ROLES/RESPONSIBILITIES: The Bay Area Workforce Development Board and its contracted WIOA service providers will prioritize access to employment and/or high-demand industry training programs for eligible and appropriate individuals actively participating in local and federal housing assistance programs in Brown County, administered by Family Services of Northeast Wisconsin. Reciprocally, Family Services of NEW and Brown County Homeless and Housing Coalition partners will refer and encourage and sponsored participants to access Bay Area Workforce Development and American Job Center services, as appropriate. Access to quality, affordable, and safe housing is critical to developing and maintaining a skilled workforce – central tenets of the signatory organizations’ joint mission statements. While no additional funding is being provided by either party, jointly coordinating and providing individually-tailored comprehensive, wrap-around services with a strong and stable housing emphasis significantly increases qualitative as well as quantifiable returns on investment and promotes long term individual, programmatic, and systemic positive goal attainment.

MODIFICATIONS: This agreement may be modified at any time during its timeframe by mutual agreement of both parties.


