


The Balance of State Continuum of Care is a 501c3 non-profit organization that provides leadership to local homeless coalitions in 69 counties across the State of Wisconsin, excluding Dane, Milwaukee, and Racine counties.

Annualized Data Cumulative data by providers serving the homeless. Totals represent those served in emergency shelters and transitional housing programs between January 1, 2016 and December 31, 2016. Only includes data reported in HMIS.



Point-In-Time (PIT) Data A "snapshot" count of those experiencing homelessness on one night. Wisconsin does this count during the last week of January and the last week of July each year. Totals represent unsheltered and those served in emergency shelters and transitional housing programs on Data is from January 27, 2016. Includes both HMIS and non-HMIS data.
