Charlotte will reach out to Salvation Army to get their data.</p> <p>Strategies to end homelessness in Ozaukee County include getting word out to providers on what resources are available. Prevent homelessness in the first place-identify those at risk of homelessness. Address root causes-AODA, DV, mental health, jobs.</p> <p>Casting the net out further to reach HR directors, get landlords together to discuss services.</p> <p>Increase in HP funding to meet needs in the community</p>
