



## WIBOSCOC Reallocation Policy

### Voluntary Reallocation:

The WIBOSCOC encourages transitional housing providers to strongly consider reallocation of their funds to permanent housing programs. Agencies have the opportunity to voluntarily reallocate funds to create permanent housing projects that better meet community need and show commitment to HUD policy priorities. Agencies may also voluntarily reduce their project funds when community need no longer justifies the funding amount. Agencies must complete the voluntary reallocation application and submit to the Project Evaluation Committee and the COC Director. The applications are reviewed by a pre-determined team to ensure compliance with HUD policy priorities and WIBOSCOC goals. The COC Director and board members assist the agency to meet HUD and BOS threshold requirements prior to approval of the application.

### Involuntary Reallocation:

The WIBOSCOC monitors projects and provides training and technical assistance to agencies that are underperforming. In such cases where projects have received substantial training and technical assistance and remain unable to meet minimum HUD and BOS performance requirements, the board shall take action to involuntarily reallocate funding. Involuntarily reallocated funds will be combined with voluntarily reduced funds to create new permanent housing projects.
