

VI-SPDAT Version 2.0 Training – Revised Instructions


To finalize your attendance and completion of VI-SPDAT Version 2.0 Training #1, you must successfully complete the Org Code Consulting VI-SPDAT Version 2 quizzes. In the past, successful participants received a certificate of completion directly from Org Code. Now, each successful participant will be required to send a document to the DLA contact and ETH lead that includes a screen shot showing the date, successful completion screen, & final quiz score.

To access the quizzes, please following the instructions below.

Note: I recommend using Mozilla Firefox or Google Chrome and clearing your cache (Control + F5) before you begin. Also, if you have technical difficulties with the Org Code website, you will need to contact Org code.

VI-SPDAT v2.0 Training

This course outlines how to complete the Vulnerability Index-Service Prioritization Decision Assistance Tool (VI-SPDAT), as created and owned by Community Solutions and OrgCode Consulting, Inc.

The VI-SPDAT is the result of a combination of two tools – the Vulnerability Index (VI) survey created by Community Solutions for use in street outreach, which helps to determine the chronicity and medical vulnerability of homeless persons, and the Service Prioritization Decision Assistance Tool (SPDAT) created by OrgCode as an intake and case management tool.

Upon completing this course, practitioners will have a detailed understanding of how the VI-SPDAT can be used as part of a coordinated entry system, how it should not be used, and how to implement the tool with clients.

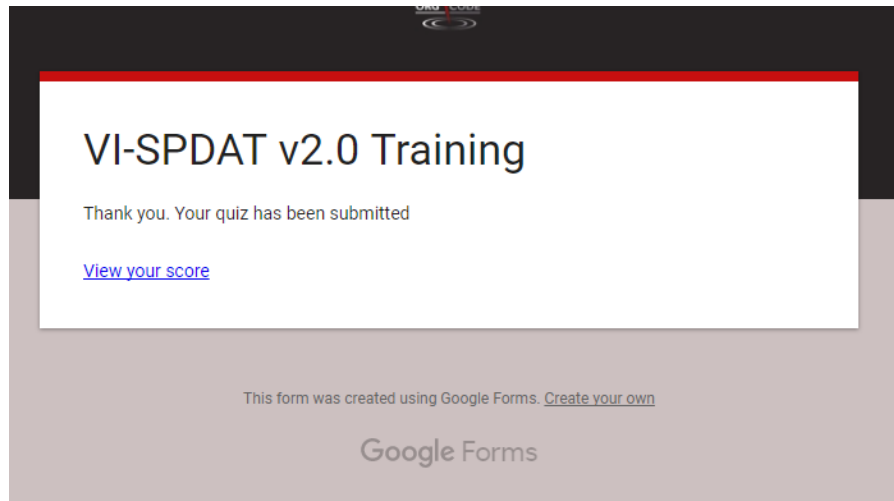

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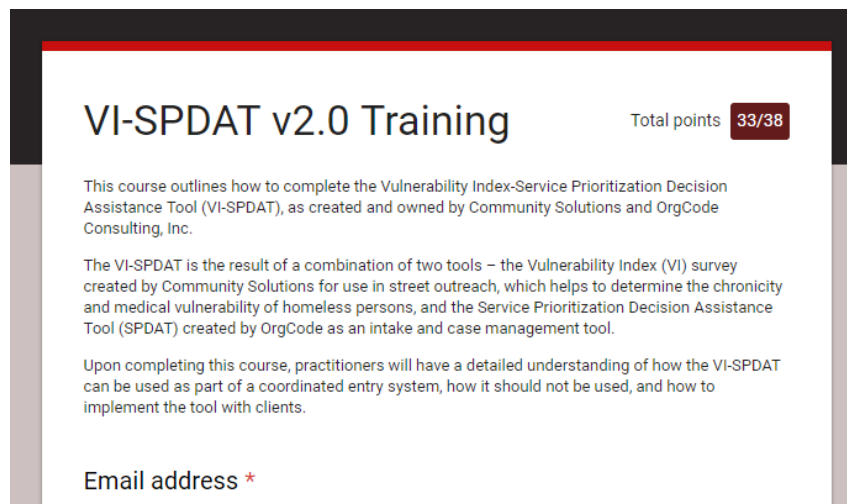
- (3) Read through the material and complete each quiz. You will need to score 75% correct in order to advance to the next quiz.

(4) When you have completed all the quizzes, the following screen will appear:



(5) Take a screen shot or snip of this screen. Make sure you include the date (usually on the lower right-hand corner of your screen). Save the screen shot or snip on a word document.

(6) Click “View your Score” and the following screen will appear:



(7) Take a screen shot or snip of this screen. Make sure you include the date (usually on the lower right-hand corner of your screen) and corresponding email address listed. Save the screen shot or snip on a word document.

(8) Save the document with the screen shot/snips on your computer. Email this document in PDF format to your DLA contact and ETH lead. This will serve as confirmation of completion.

**You might be familiar with screen shots and the snipping tool. If not, please google each for instructions that will best work with your computer set-up.*
