Access to Emergency Services

1. Individuals and families will be referred to SA Faith House Emergency Shelter (715-349-8744). Faith house is staffed from 8-4 Monday thru Friday. Access by phone is 24 hours per day. SA faith house will provide a motel voucher after hours. Emergency transportation is provided by local law enforcement.
2. Interfaith Caregivers (715-866-4970) also provides motel vouchers after hours. Phone access is available 24 hours per day.
3. If either program is unable to be reached Siren Police (715-349-7181), St. Croix Tribal Police (715-349-8638), and Burnett County Sheriffs Department also able to issue motel vouchers.

If someone is fleeing domestic violence:

1. Contact Community Referral Agency in Milltown (800-261-7233).
2. Law enforcement can also issues a motel voucher.

Connection to Coordinates Entry

1. Individuals and households that are sheltered through Salvation Army, Interfaith caregivers or local police will be referred to Coordinated Entry through The Salvation Army (715-349-8744 or 715-529-0981).
2. If individuals are sheltered through Community Referral Agency the individual will be referred to Salvation Army to provide access to the Coordinated Entry System during normal business hours. Appointed staff are trained to do the VI-SPDAT with clients that are residing at a DV shelter or need to access homeless service.

Point in Time Count

Burnett County scheduled the PIT count for July 27,2022. The count began at 11:00PM and was completed by 3:30AM the following morning. We had 2 homeless individuals that were put in motels paid with by vouchers. We focused on Siren, Grantsburg, Webster, Trade Lake, Danbury and Webb Lake. We did not count areas that are heavily wooded or covered by water (lakes, streams and rivers.) Agencies receiving ESG funds completed the count.
