

## **Sawyer County**

### **Access to Emergency Services**

1. Individuals and families will be referred to The Salvation Army Women's Shelter (715-634-1050). The Salvation Army Shelter is staffed from 8-4 Monday thru Friday. To access additional services after hour's homeless individuals and families may contact the Hayward police at (715-934-8962 or dial 911) to provide a motel voucher.

If someone is fleeing domestic violence:

1. Contact Oak Wood Haven in Hayward (715-634-9360).
2. Law enforcement can also issues a motel voucher.

### **Connection to Coordinates Entry**

1. Individuals and households that are sheltered through The Salvation Army or local police will be referred to Coordinated Entry through The Salvation Army (715-529-0981)
2. If individuals are sheltered through Oak Wood Haven, the individual will be referred to The Salvation Army (715-529-0981 or 715-634-1050) to provide access to the Coordinated Entry System during normal business hours. Appointed staff are trained to do the VI-SPDAT with clients that are residing at a DV shelter or need to access homeless service.

### **Point in Time Count**

Sawyer County scheduled the PIT count for July 27, 2022. The count began at 1:100PM and was completed by 3:00AM the following morning. We did not locate any unsheltered individuals. We focused on Hayward, Winter, Exeland, Stone Lake and Radisson. We did not count areas that are heavily wooded or covered by water (lakes, streams and rivers.) The homeless shelter in Sawyer County completed the count they do not receive ESG funding.
